Renewals – Special Circumstances

Paula Adams, Store Manager scheduled to appear on behalf of Mini Mart Inc.

The Authority explained to Ms. Adams that Loaf 'N Jug was not renewed on the consent agenda because they had a violation of the liquor code in the last year. The Authority asked Ms. Adams to introduce herself and explain what changes had taken place at the store to ensure compliance with all State liquor laws.

Paula Adams stated that she started as the store manager in January of 2014 at this location. Ms. Adams explained that the employees are now trained by watching videos that the company supplies. She also stated that once a month the company sends in a "secret shopper" to attempt to buy alcohol. This store has passed the last eleven checks. Last, they have a sign on the cash register which states ID is required as well as big sign that is in plain view of all customers. The cash register also prompts the cashier to ask for ID on every alcohol sale. The purchaser must hand the cashier the ID, which is then swiped. This is important because this allows the cashier to put their hands on the ID and can get a good look to make sure it looks and feels valid.

The Authority also reminded Ms. Adams that Colorado ID's for minors are a portrait orientation versus landscape for legal adults.

Finding:

The Windsor Liquor License Authority reviewed the renewal application and materials contained in the file, heard the testimony and considered the factors contained in Colorado Liquor Code and feels that appropriate steps have been taken by the company to ensure no more violations occur. There have been no violations since the last occurrence which displays further evidence that these are effective. The authority approved the license renewal.

D. OLD / NEW BUSINESS


There was no additional business.
