A. CALL TO ORDER

The Authority called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

The Authority asked if anyone had reason to amend the Consent Calendar. Hearing none, the Consent Calendar was approved as presented.

C. OLD BUSINESS

1. Request for Special Event Permit for Athletes in Tandem, 2225 W. Vine Drive, Windsor, CO 80550

Dennis Vanderheiden representing Athletes in Tandem was present to address the Liquor Authority.

The Authority asked about the nature of the event.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated it was a sprint triathlon to include a swim in Windsor Lake for approximately 80 meters, a 10 meter bike ride and a 5k run finishing at the lake.

The Authority asked if it was the first time holding the event.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated he has held the event for the past 3 years.

The Authority asked they held a liquor license in the past years.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated they have held a license the past two years.

The Authority asked if there were any issues in the previous years.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated there were none.

The Authority asked what training the volunteers will have that will be serving liquor.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated they obtain volunteers that have helped in other community events. The volunteers that will be helping at this event have volunteered at many events in Fort Collins that contain beer gardens.

The Authority recommended that servers do not drink while they are serving and asked if that is something that may be an issue.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated the volunteers will not abuse the situation.

The Authority asked if arm bands will be used or any other way to distinguish who is over 21 and who is not.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated their age is on their race bibs and that's what they look at.

The Authority asked if volunteers will be checking ID's as well.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated individuals looking to be underage will have their ID checked.

The Authority asked what food will be available.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated they are working with Whole Foods to supply food. They are going to have a brunch fair including oatmeal, muffins and fruit.

The Authority asked where the underage sign and the liquor permit will be posted.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated they will have portable livestock panels to fence in the beer garden and they will be posted on those panels.

The Authority asked Mr. Vanderheiden if there was anything else outside of the information provided in the application packet that he would like the Authority to know.

Mr. Vanderheiden stated Athletes in Tandem is a non-profit and this event is fundraiser for them.

The Authority asked what Athletes in Tandem was.

Mr. Vanderheiden state they match individuals with disabilities and pull them through triathlons and running events.

The Authority asked if there was anyone in the audience that wished to be heard on the application to which there was none.

FINDING:

The Windsor Liquor License Authority reviewed the Special Event application and materials contained in the file, heard the testimony and considered the factors contained in Colorado Liquor Code and feels that the required criteria for issuance of a special event permit have been met. The authority approved the special event permit.
