The Authority inquired if Mr. Romero will be responsible for the liquor license.

The Authority stated they will not be able to proceed without a qualified court interpreter and asked the applicant to return on May 16, 2016 at 3:30 p.m. with a qualified interpreter. The Authority reminded the applicant that the temporary permit will still allow them to serve alcohol.
