ROSTER REQUIREMENTS AND CHANGES

1. **All players play at their own risk.**
2. Each team manager is responsible for bringing a signed waiver for each player to the managers meeting. Adult meeting is at 8am. Youth team meeting is at 10:30. Parent/guardian must sign for anyone under 18.
3. Players may only play on one team.
4. All teams must have 2 members of the opposite sex on the court at all times. No COED rule!
5. Team managers are also responsible for the team participants and their fans.

EQUIPMENT, JERSEYS, AND FACILITIES

1. The Windsor Recreation Department will provide the game facility and volleyballs.
2. **The Town of Windsor strongly encourages that each player wear shoes during their game. The mud may contain objects that may scratch or cut your feet.**
3. Teams are **NOT** required to wear jerseys of similar color or jerseys with numbers.
4. Water is non-potable. Do not drink.
5. Park rules state only 3.2 beer is allowed, no glass. Only grills under 200 square inches will be allowed per Town of Windsor ordinance.

TOURNAMENT

1. The tournament will be double elimination. **A team captain must report to Diamond Valley by 8:00AM for adult teams and 10:30 for youth teams.**
2. A trophy will be given to the 1st place - 4th place finishers in the adult division. Youth divisions top 4 teams will get participant trophies.
3. Match regulations and tournament play may be modified by the Recreation staff to better accommodate the tournament and number of teams.

MATCH REGULATIONS

1. Matches will consist of one game to 24 points (switch sides at 12), win by two (cap at 26) or **15 minutes**, whichever comes first. Rally scoring. Team will call score before each serve.
2. Matches may be started with as few as two players. Maximum six players on the court at one time. Substitutions can be made on a dead ball.
3. **Players must call and score their own game. If there is a disagreement, a replay will be called.**
4. Rotate clockwise. You must rotate.

5. Blocking and attacking the serve is illegal and will result in a sideout.
6. Any ball, which momentarily comes to rest on a player's arms or hands, will be considered a lift. Please be honest!
7. Any participant who is bleeding, or has an open wound, or has an excessive amount of blood on his or her uniform must leave the game or event. The participant may not return until either the bleeding has stopped, or the wound has been covered, and the uniform has been changed.
8. Match time is forfeit time. Always be at the site early in case the games are running ahead of schedule. We will start early if games are ahead of the scheduled time.
9. Individuals with plaster casts or other injury healing devices are not allowed to participate in any games sponsored, hosted, or operated by the Windsor Parks and Recreation Department. Knee braces may be worn.
10. There will be no protests allowed.
11. Players may serve from anywhere along the end line inside the pit. A ball that hits the net on a serve and goes over is a playable ball.
12. You may play the ball off of any part of the body.
13. All net violations must be called.
14. Crossing under the net is permitted unless it interferes with the play of the opposing team or is flagrant.
15. Open hand dinks are allowed provided the ball isn't caught, thrown or lifted.
16. Play the water. If it touches the water, it's in. If it doesn't, it's out.
17. Current Volleyball rules and regulations are in effect for all situations not already listed.

PLAYER AND MANAGER CONDUCT

1. Each manager will be responsible for the conduct of his/her players and spectators.
2. No player or spectator may verbally or physically attack any player, staff, or spectator.
3. All players will conduct themselves in a mature way and use good sportsmanship at all times.
4. The Recreation staff's decisions are final and players may not argue with them.
5. The Recreation staff reserves the right to determine punishment for any misconduct.
