## A YEAR IN REVIEW



### CRC GRAND OPENING

After 13 months of construction, the newly-remodeled **Windsor Community Recreation Center** opened on October 8, enabling access to an addition 35,000 square feet of recreational space. New amenities include an indoor aquatic center, weight room, fitness rooms, walking track and auxiliary gym.



### BOARDWALK BANDSHELL

The Town of Windsor introduced Boardwalk Park's new Bandshell in May 2016. The Bandshell serves as the home of our **Summer Concert Series** on Thursdays. The event offers a variety of live musical genres and continues to draw crowds averaging 1,800 people.



### PICKLEBALL COURTS

November 1 marked the opening of the largest outdoor Pickleball court complex in northern Colorado at Windsor's own Main Park. The complex features **six outdoor courts**, and replaces the outdoor roller hockey rinks that were rarely used and required heavy maintenance.
