

Introducing the Expanded Windsor Community Recreation Center

In 2016, Windsor Parks, Recreation & Culture completed construction of a 40,000-square-foot expansion to the Windsor Recreation Center. The \$16.1 million-dollar expansion includes extensive improvements to the gymnasium and fitness rooms and the addition of an indoor aquatic facility, as well as a variety of other rooms and amenities.

Indoor Aquatic Center

An indoor aquatic facility serves as the expansion's centerpiece, featuring three lap lanes, a zero-depth entry pool with play feature, a lazy river, water slide, and a 23-person hot tub! The full Aquatics section begins on **Page 16**.

Fitness Facilities

A state-of-the-art auxiliary gym with an elevated walking and jogging track connects the 16,000-square-foot renovated space. Need your child taken care of during your facility use? Up to eight children can take advantage of our childcare services in our brand new Kids Corner! CRC GRAND OPENING

After 13 months of construction, the newly-remodeled **Windsor Community Recreation Center** opened on October 8, enabling access to an addition 35,000 square feet of recreational space. New amenities include an indoor aquatic center, weight room, fitness rooms, walking track and auxiliary gym.


