

Toilet Rebate Information and Program Rules 2018

High efficiency toilet rebate rules:

- Toilet(s) must be purchased between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.
- Rebate applications must be submitted within 90 days of purchase. All toilets purchased between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018, must be submitted before January 15, 2019.
- New toilets must replace toilets older than 1994 that flush at least 3.5 gallons per flush.
- Only water customers in good standing (non-delinquent account) may apply. Windsor residents receiving
 water from Loveland/Fort Collins Water District must provide a letter from the District stating they are in
 good standing with a non-delinquent account. Toilets must be installed within the Town of Windsor.
- If renting, you must have a letter signed by the property owner authorizing you to install a new toilet.
- Rebate is limited to two toilets per residence; installation must be complete before applying.
- Receive up to a \$50 rebate on a new toilet; rebates are subject to available funds.
- New homes and new construction (addition of new bathrooms) are not eligible for the rebate.
- The Town reserves the right to inspect the installation of any appliance for which a rebate is provided. Rebates can be filed by the property owners or renters. Contractors or others working for a property they do not own cannot apply for the rebate. The homeowner is responsible for installation.

How to apply:

- Bring completed form and receipt of purchase to the Town of Windsor, 301 Walnut Street, Windsor, CO 80550. Applications are accepted in person, by mail or email.
- If you file by mail or email you will need to have the application notarized.
- A copy of your ID will be required. A Colorado driver's license is the preferred form of ID. We will also accept U.S. military card or passport.
