Background / Discussion:

Last fall, the Parks, Recreation, and Culture Department was approached by the Weld Re-4 School District to participate on an advisory board for the ACE (Alternative Cooperation Program). Tara Fotsch volunteered and has joined the Advisory Board as the Town representative. Doing so has opened up opportunities with the different cooperative groups within the district.

The District is interested in expanding their opportunities to the Town of Windsor for the upcoming 2019-20 school year, and the presentation will focus on the opportunities below:

- SWAP – The School to Work Alliance Program is a vocational program that supports young adults aged 15-24 in preparing for, finding employment or maintaining employment. SWAP services help participants identify skill levels, abilities and interests while providing guidance in pursuing well suite employment. Participants must apply and be found eligible for services.
- ACE – Alternative Cooperative Education is a career and technical education program designed specifically for high risk and special population students. It addresses students' individual needs and works to transition students from high school to post-secondary education training, and/or the workforce. ACE exposes students to the workforce and teaches students the soft skills needed in all occupations.
- COE – Cooperative Opportunity Employment is a vocational program that is offered to High School Seniors completing specific business classes. The students go through the application process, interviews and are then selected by various participating businesses in the community for work related experiences. These are paid positions and the students work approximately 10-15 hours per week. The students also receive credits for these positions.

Staff will be seeking, consensus from the Board to proceed in forming a team with a point of contact that will work directly with Weld Re-4 School District to offer these opportunities throughout the year.
